



- In our case, I'm talking about a **good** information security professional.
- The good ones are more rare than you think. Heck, <u>any</u> one if rarer than you think.
- We don't have enough unicorns.

FACT #2 - YOU WOULDN'T RECOGNIZE ONE IF YOU SAW ONE.

What do they look like?

- They come in all shapes, sizes, and colors.
- Unicorns have nothing to do with looks.
- Unicorns have everything to do with what they can do for you.
- Latino and Black employees are massively under-represented, with less than 10% of the workforce across many large organizations (this includes Facebook, Microsoft, and Salesforce).
- A report by McKinsey found that companies with better minority employment records had a 35% greater financial return than the industry median.

- You'll be surprised what you find.



You have a choice.

Attracting a unicorn.

- It's all about culture.
- Unicorns need proper care to reach their full potential.
- Once a unicorn realizes that he/she is a unicorn, they will demand to be treated like a unicorn (meaning treated well).

- Equip them. Don't be afraid to invest heavily into them. If they go, you'll still be better off.









FACT #7 – EVERYBODY WANTS UNICORNS.

Including your competition.

- Losing a unicorn isn't losing.
- It's painful sometimes, but the pain is healthy.
- People are recruiting your unicorns every single day.
- Be the best you, focus on your culture, and don't worry about it.
- Plan contingencies though...







BONUS - DON'T CALL A UNICORN A UNICORN.

Weird right?

- Unicorns can get an attitude.
- Unicorns have egos too.
- Unicorns are special, but calling them special can have consequences.
- Instead of calling them unicorns or calling them special...
